Clinic shares space in the Upcounty Regional Services Center with the Dept. of Health & Human								
Services.								
Although the allotted space was adequate early on , the growth of the Clinic has rendered that space								
operationally inefficient and one that exacerbates security issues for both staff and patients. The								
Clinic needs more space to accommodate greater patient numbers We believe that a larger,								
professionally designed space will attract and acccommodate more volunteer physicians and health								
care professionals. The public library is scheduled to move out of the building to a new site in the								
fall of 2005. We would like to renovate some of this space to improve our efficiency and enable us								
to increase the number of patient visits that we can provide.
