This bill alters legislation passed in the 2004 session to allow the grantee to use real property or in kind contributions to fulfil the match requirement.

<b>9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization</b>		
The Mission of Love, Inc, located in Capitol Heights, Maryland is a multifaceted health and human services organization dedicated to meeting the survival needs of vulnerable and at-risk individuals and families. The Mission is committed to preventing and remedying homelessness and hopelessness by first satisfying the most basic human needs of food, clothing, shelter and security; secondly, by equipping clients with the tools needed for long-term stability and growth.

The administrative office recently merged operations with the warehouse, thus making it necessary to add additional office space.
