AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1585
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after “changes;” insert “requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to study certain issues relating to driver licensing for the operation of motor homes; requiring the Administration to report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, after line 13, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) The Motor Vehicle Administration shall study issues relating to the licensing of drivers of motor homes, including:

(1) training;

(2) testing;

(3) requiring an endorsement for motor homes on a noncommercial Class C driver’s license;

(4) the feasibility of grandfathering licensees who currently drive motor homes;
and

(5) any other issues identified by the Administration.

(b) On or before December 31, 2006, the Administration shall report its findings to the

(Over)

General Assembly in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article.”;
in line 14, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”; and in line 15, strike “October 1, 2006.” and substitute
“June 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2007, with
no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further
force and effect.”.
