- 16 (c) Each of the judges of the Court for Anne Arundel County shall receive an
- 17 annual compensation of [\$19,000] \$29,000, and the Chief Judge shall receive an
- 18 additional \$500 annually. Each judge shall also receive an expense allowance up to
- 19 \$150 per month for personal expenses incidental to his duties, to be paid by the
- 20 Comptroller of Anne Arundel County each month upon presentation of an itemized
- 21 voucher in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the Comptroller.

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
- 2 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
- 3 the salary or compensation of the judges of the Orphans' Court of Anne Arundel
