A BILL ENTITLED

2 **Maryland Military Department - Maryland Defense Force Employment**

4 FOR the purpose of providing employment protection to members of the Maryland
5 Defense Force; and generally relating to the Maryland Defense Force.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Public Safety**

14 13-705.

15 (a) The rights granted to members of the National Guard AND MARYLAND
16 DEFENSE FORCE by this section shall be in addition to the rights granted to them by
17 federal law, including the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940 and the
18 Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act.

19 (b) The following provisions of federal law shall be adopted as State law and
20 applied to members of the National Guard AND MARYLAND DEFENSE FORCE:

21 (1) the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940 applies only when
22 members of the National Guard OR MARYLAND DEFENSE FORCE are ordered to
23 military duty under this title or Title 10 or Title 32 of the United States Code for a
24 period of 14 consecutive days or longer; and

25 (2) the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act
26 applies when members of the National Guard OR MARYLAND DEFENSE FORCE are

1 ordered to military duty under this title or Title 10 or Title 32 of the United States
2 Code for any period of time.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
4 effect October 1, 2006.
