15 (a) The rights granted to members of the National Guard AND MARYLAND

16 DEFENSE FORCE by this section shall be in addition to the rights granted to them by

18 Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act.

19(b)The following provisions of federal law shall be adopted as State law and20applied to members of the National Guard AND MARYLAND DEFENSE FORCE:

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1 (1) the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940 applies only when

2 members of the National Guard OR MARYLAND DEFENSE FORCE are ordered to

3 military duty under this title or Title 10 or Title 32 of the United States Code for a
