CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Beer and Wine Tasting or**  
3 **Sampling**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing in St. Mary's County a 1-day Class BWTS beer and  
5 wine (on-premises) tasting or sampling license; specifying certain persons to  
6 whom a license may be issued; providing for a license fee; authorizing the holder  
7 of a license to allow the consumption of wine or beer under certain conditions;  
8 establishing certain restrictions on consumption; limiting the number of licenses  
9 that may be granted to a person in a calendar year; requiring the disposal of  
10 unconsumed alcoholic beverages in a certain way; and generally relating to  
11 Class BWTS beer and wine licenses in St. Mary's County.

13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
14 Section 8-410.2

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 8-410.2.

21 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY.

1 (B) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A 1-DAY CLASS  
2 BWTS BEER AND WINE (ON-PREMISES) TASTING OR SAMPLING LICENSE.

3 (C) A CLASS BWTS LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A  
4 CURRENT ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OR AN ORGANIZATION THAT QUALIFIES  
5 FOR A SPECIAL CLASS C BEER, SPECIAL CLASS C BEER AND WINE LICENSE, OR A  
6 SPECIAL CLASS C BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE UNDER § 7-101(R) OF THIS  
7 ARTICLE.

8 (D) THE LICENSE FEE IS \$50.

9 (E) A CLASS BWTS LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO ALLOW THE  
10 CONSUMPTION OF WINE OR BEER FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING, IF THE ALCOHOLIC  
11 BEVERAGES ARE GIVEN TO CONSUMERS AT NO CHARGE.

12 (F) A PERSON MAY CONSUME WINE OR BEER COVERED BY A CLASS BWTS  
13 LICENSE IN A QUANTITY NOT EXCEEDING:

14 (1) 1 OUNCE FROM A SINGLE BRAND OF WINE, AND 4 OUNCES FROM ALL  
15 BRANDS IN A SINGLE DAY; AND

16 (2) 3 OUNCES FROM A SINGLE BRAND OF BEER, AND 8 OUNCES FROM  
17 ALL BRANDS IN A SINGLE DAY.

18 (G) ALL CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SHALL OCCUR ON THE  
19 LICENSED PREMISES OF THE HOLDER OF THE CLASS BWTS LICENSE.

20 (H) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS NEED NOT PUBLISH AN  
21 APPLICATION FOR A CLASS BWTS LICENSE BEFORE GRANTING THE LICENSE.

22 (I) A CLASS BWTS LICENSE MAY NOT BE GRANTED TO A PERSON MORE THAN  
23 12 TIMES IN A CALENDAR YEAR.

24 (J) AT THE END OF THE DAY FOR WHICH A CLASS BWTS LICENSE IS VALID,  
25 THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL DISPOSE OF UNCONSUMED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES  
26 REMAINING IN A CONTAINER OPENED FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
28 July 1, 2006.
