Department of Health and Mental Hygiene - Prenatal Dietary <u>Folic Acid</u> Supplement Distribution Program

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to

5 establish a program to distribute prenatal multivitamin <u>appropriate vitamins</u>

6 and mineral dietary supplements *a folic acid supplement* to women of a certain

7 age <u>and income level</u>; providing for the purpose of the program; requiring the

8 program to provide <u>a</u> certain supplements <u>supplement</u> and certain counseling

9 and information to certain individuals; requiring local health departments to

10 distribute certain supplements and to provide certain counseling and

11 information; requiring the program to be funded in the State budget, subject to

12 the availability of funding; authorizing the Department to use money

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1 appropriated for a certain federal program and from any other lawful source to

2 fund the program; and generally relating to a prenatal dietary *folic acid*

3 supplement distribution program in the Department of Health and Mental

4 Hygiene.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- SUBTITLE 23. PRENATAL DIETARY FOLIC ACID SUPPLEMENT DISTRIBUTION
 PROGRAM.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "WOMEN OF CHILDBEARING AGE" MEANS WOMEN BETWEEN
 THE AGES OF 15 AND 45 YEARS OLD WHO QUALIFY FOR THE FEDERAL WOMEN,
 INFANTS, AND CHILDREN FOOD PROGRAM HAVE FAMILY INCOMES AT OR BELOW
 185% OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL.

23 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO DISTRIBUTE
24 PRENATAL MULTIVITAMIN <u>ANY APPROPRIATE VITAMIN</u> AND MINERAL DIETARY
25 SUPPLEMENTS <u>A FOLIC ACID SUPPLEMENT</u> TO WOMEN OF CHILDBEARING AGE.

26 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF CASES
27 OF NEURAL TUBE DEFECTS AND OTHER BIRTH DEFECTS IN CHILDREN AND TO
28 REDUCE THE NUMBER OF INFANTS BORN WITH LOW BIRTH WEIGHT IN THE STATE.

29 (C) THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING TO WOMEN OF
30 CHILDBEARING AGE <u>AS APPROPRIATE, BASED ON AN ASSESSMENT OF THEIR</u>
31 <u>INDIVIDUAL NEED</u>:

(1) PRENATAL MULTIVITAMIN <u>APPROPRIATE VITAMIN AND MINERAL</u>
 DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS THAT CONTAIN <u>AN APPROPRIATE FOLIC ACID SUPPLEMENT</u>
 <u>THAT CONTAINS</u> THE RECOMMENDED LEVEL OF FOLIC ACID FOR WOMEN OF
 CHILDBEARING AGE;

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1 (3) ANY OTHER <u>HEALTH</u> INFORMATION <u>REGARDING PRENATAL CARE</u> 2 THAT THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF 3 THIS SUBTITLE.

4 (D) LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE PRENATAL
5 DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS AND PROVIDE THE COUNSELING AND WRITTEN
6 INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.

8 (A) <u>SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING</u>, THE PROGRAM SHALL BE 9 FUNDED AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

10 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY USE MONEY APPROPRIATED FOR THE FEDERAL
 11 WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN FOOD PROGRAM AND FROM ANY OTHER LAWFUL
 12 SOURCE TO FUND THE PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2006.

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
