A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County - Board of Electrical Examiners and Plumbing Board -**
3 **Members - Appointment**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that the Board of Electrical Examiners for Calvert
5 County shall be appointed by the Governor from a certain list submitted by the
6 Calvert County Electrical Contractors Association or the Calvert County
7 Democratic Central Committee and the Calvert County Republican Central
8 Committee under certain circumstances; providing that the Calvert County
9 plumbing board shall be appointed by the Governor from a certain list
10 submitted by the members of the master plumbers association or the Calvert
11 County Democratic Central Committee and the Calvert County Republican
12 Central Committee under certain circumstances; making a certain technical
13 change; and generally relating to the appointment of members to the Board of
14 Electrical Examiners for Calvert County and the Calvert County plumbing
15 board.

26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 5 - Calvert County

2 9-102.

3 (a) A three-member Board of Electrical Examiners and supervisors for
4 Calvert County is created for the purpose of examining the qualifications and
5 capabilities of all persons who are engaged or desire to engage in the business of
6 electrician as defined in this subtitle.

7 (b) The board shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent
8 of the senate from a list of five persons submitted by the Calvert County Electrical
9 Contractors Association, or, if this association does not exist, by the [state central
10 committee] CALVERT COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND THE
11 CALVERT COUNTY REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

13 (a) The Calvert County plumbing board consists of three members selected by
14 the governor, and with the advice [find] AND consent of the senate, from a list of five
15 persons submitted by the members of the master plumbers association or, if this
16 association does not exist, by the [state central committee] CALVERT COUNTY
17 DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND THE CALVERT COUNTY REPUBLICAN
18 CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2006.
