5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 6 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to 7 the salary or compensation of the County Commissioners of Calvert County, Calvert 8 County Treasurer, Sheriff of Calvert County, or Orphans' Court Judges for Calvert 9 County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act 10 concerning the salary or compensation of the County Commissioners of Calvert 11 County, Calvert County Treasurer, Sheriff of Calvert County, or Orphans' Court 12 Judges for Calvert County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term 13 of office.

14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 2006.
