A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Traffic Control Devices - "No Outlet" Signs**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a local authority to install a sign with the words "no  
4 outlet" when the local authority places or replaces in its jurisdiction a sign  
5 indicating a highway will end in a dead end or cul-de-sac or marking the  
6 entrance to a highway or highway network from which there is no other exit;  
7 requiring a sign installed under this Act to conform to a certain manual and  
8 specifications adopted by the State Highway Administration; and generally  
9 relating to the placement or replacement of certain traffic control devices.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Transportation**

18 25-106.2.

19 (A) A LOCAL AUTHORITY SHALL INSTALL A SIGN WITH THE WORDS "NO  
20 OUTLET" WHEN THE LOCAL AUTHORITY PLACES OR REPLACES IN ITS JURISDICTION  
21 A SIGN THAT:

22 (1) INDICATES THAT A HIGHWAY WILL TERMINATE IN A DEAD END OR A  
23 CUL-DE-SAC; OR

24 (2) MARKS THE ENTRANCE TO A HIGHWAY OR HIGHWAY NETWORK  
25 FROM WHICH THERE IS NO OTHER EXIT.

26 (B) A SIGN INSTALLED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL  
27 CONFORM TO THE MANUAL AND SPECIFICATIONS ADOPTED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY  
28 ADMINISTRATION UNDER § 25-104 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
2 October 1, 2006.
