2 **Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School - Cessation of Operations - Transfer of**
3 **Property**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the transfer of the real property and all rights of
5 physical control over the real property of the Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School to the
6 Department of Natural Resources if the Department of Juvenile Services ceases
7 to operate the school in a certain manner; requiring certain transferred property
8 to become a part of Gunpowder Falls State Park; and generally relating to the
9 Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83C - Juvenile Services

3 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING § 10-304 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT
4 ARTICLE, IF THE DEPARTMENT CEASES TO OPERATE THE CHARLES H. HICKEY, JR.
5 SCHOOL AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE REAL PROPERTY OF THE SCHOOL
6 AND ALL RIGHTS OF PHYSICAL CONTROL OVER THE REAL PROPERTY OF THE SCHOOL
7 ARE TRANSFERRED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

8 (B) PROPERTY TRANSFERRED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
9 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BECOME A PART OF GUNPOWDER FALLS STATE PARK.

Article - State Finance and Procurement

11 10-304.

12 (a) This section does not apply to:

13 (1) property that is pledged to secure the payment of principal of or
14 interest on revenue bonds; or

15 (2) real property that is owned or controlled by the State Highway
16 Administration.

17 (b) (1) The Board may transfer any property, and all rights of physical
18 custody and control over the property, from a unit of the Executive Branch of the
19 State government to another unit of the Executive Branch of the State government.

20 (2) Any property transferred under this subsection is subject to the
21 continuing general jurisdiction of the Board.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2006.
