Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 558 – *Criminal Offenses - Driving Without a License - Arrest and Penalties*.

This bill authorizes a police officer to arrest an individual without a warrant for the violation of driving without a license if the officer has probable cause to believe that the individual has committed the violation; and alters a penalty.

House Bill 524, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 558.
