AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 571

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “Juveniles” in line 2 down through “Drive” in line 3 and substitute “Truancy – Prohibition Against Issuance of Learner’s Instructional Permit”.

On pages 1 and 2, strike beginning with the second “the” in line 4 on page 1 down through “school” in line 6 on page 2 and substitute “certain applicants for a learner’s instructional permit to present to the Motor Vehicle Administration the applicant’s school attendance record; prohibiting the Administration from issuing a learner’s instructional permit to certain applicants if the applicant’s school attendance record indicates a certain number of unexcused absences; and generally relating to the issuance of learner’s instructional permits and truancy”.

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 7 through 16, inclusive; in line 19, after “7-301(a)” insert “(1)”; and strike in their entirety lines 22 through 31, inclusive.

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 5, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 8 on page 3 through line 22 on page 4, inclusive.

On pages 5 through 7, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 1 on page 5 through line 2 on page 7, inclusive.

On pages 7 and 8, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 4 on page 7 through line 3 on page 8, inclusive.

(Over)

On page 8, in line 13, after “(3)” insert “(I)”; strike beginning with “THE” in line 13 down through “PRESENTS” in line 15 and substitute “EACH APPLICANT FOR A LEARNER’S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS SHALL PRESENT”; strike beginning with the colon in line 15 down through “SCHOOL,” in line 17; strike beginning with the semicolon in line 18 down through “SCHOOL” in line 24; and after line 24, insert:

“(II) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT ISSUE A LEARNER’S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT TO AN APPLICANT UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS IF THE APPLICANT’S SCHOOL ATTENDANCE RECORD INDICATES MORE THAN 10 UNEXCUSED ABSENCES WITHIN THE PAST CALENDAR YEAR.”

On pages 8 and 9, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 25 on page 8 through line 22 on page 9, inclusive.
