AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after "dates;" insert "<u>providing that the provisions of</u> <u>certain Acts of the General Assembly may not take effect; repealing certain provisions</u> <u>of law;</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 9, insert:

"<u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That the provisions of Chapter 5 and Chapter 61 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2006, as they relate to voting on days before the dates specified in the Maryland Constitution, which were struck down by the Maryland Court of Appeals (Lamone v. Capozzi, per curiam order issued August 2006), may not take effect even if this Act becomes effective.

<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 10–301.1 and</u> <u>10–302(b)(2) of Article – Election Law of the Annotated Code of Maryland be</u> <u>repealed.</u>".

and in lines 10 and 15, strike "2." and "3.", respectively, and substitute "<u>4.</u>" and "<u>5.</u>", respectively.
