AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1207  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Chair, Judiciary Committee (By Request – Departmental – Public Safety and Correctional Services)” and substitute “Delegates Dumais, Ali, Barkley, Barve, Bronrott, Elmore, Feldman, Gilchrist, Gutierrez, Heller, Hixson, Hucker, Kaiser, Kelly, N. King, Kramer, Lawton, Lee, Levi, Manno, Mizeur, Montgomery, Rice, Rosenberg, Simmons, Smigiel, Sophocleus, Taylor, F. Turner, Valderrama, and Waldstreicher”; in line 2, strike “Acts” and substitute “Contact”; strike beginning with the second “an” in line 7 down through “Services” in line 8 and substitute “a person”; and in line 9, strike “certain individuals” and substitute “an individual confined in a certain juvenile facility; expanding the applicability of a prohibition against certain sexual acts with an individual confined in a certain juvenile facility; expanding the list of actions that are cause for automatic termination of employment from the State Personnel Management System to include violation of a certain prohibition against engaging in certain sexual acts with inmates in correctional and juvenile facilities”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 2, after “**FACILITY**” insert “**, WHETHER ON A PAID OR VOLUNTEER BASIS**”; and in line 6, strike “An employee or licensee of the Department of Juvenile Services” and substitute “**A PERSON**”.
