A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006 – Anne Arundel County –**
3 **Hancock’s Resolution Visitor’s Center**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006
5 to expand the authorized uses of a certain grant to the Board of Directors of
6 Friends of Hancock’s Resolution, Inc.; and making this Act an emergency
7 measure.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Chapter 46 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2006
10 Section 1(3) Item ZA01 (O)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (O) Hancock’s Resolution Visitor Center. Provide a grant
2 equal to the lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the
3 matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of
4 Friends of Hancock’s Resolution, Inc. for the planning and
5 design of a new visitor center at Hancock’s Resolution,
6 **INCLUDING RELATED SITE WORK**, located in Pasadena,
7 subject to a requirement that the grantee grant and
8 convey a historic easement to the Maryland Historical
9 Trust. Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the
10 matching fund may consist of real property (Anne
11 Arundel County)..... 100,000

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
13 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
14 has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
15 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
16 the date it is enacted.
