1 AN ACT concerning

### Alcohol Without Liquid Machines

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of Alcohol Without Liquid (AWOL) machines to inhale alcohol vapor or otherwise introduce alcohol in any form into the human body; prohibiting the possession, purchase, transfer, or offering for sale or use, with a certain intent, of Alcohol Without Liquid machines; providing a certain penalty; defining a certain term; and generally relating to Alcohol Without Liquid machines.

1	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "AWOL MACHINE" MEANS AN ALCOHOL
2	WITHOUT LIQUID DEVICE THAT MIXES AN ALCOHOLIC PRODUCT WITH PURE
3	OXYGEN OR OTHER GAS TO PRODUCE A VAPORIZED PRODUCT THAT CAN BE
4	INHALED.

## (B) A PERSON MAY NOT:

- 6 (1) USE AN AWOL MACHINE TO INHALE ALCOHOL VAPOR OR 7 OTHERWISE INTRODUCE ALCOHOL IN ANY FORM INTO THE HUMAN BODY; OR
- 8 (2) WITH THE INTENT TO INTRODUCE ALCOHOL INTO THE HUMAN 9 BODY, POSSESS, PURCHASE, TRANSFER, OR OFFER FOR SALE OR USE AN AWOL 10 MACHINE.
- 11 (C) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
  12 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING
  13 \$1,000.
- 14 (2) EACH VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
