Local Government - Street Lighting Equipment

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a local government to purchase certain street lighting 4 equipment from an electric company; requiring a local government to pay fair 5 market value for the purchase of certain street lighting equipment; providing 6 that a local government that purchases certain street lighting equipment is 7 responsible for the maintenance of the street lighting equipment and may 8 contract with an outside entity for the maintenance of the street lighting 9 equipment; requiring a person that controls the right to use space on certain 10 poles, lampposts, or other mounting surfaces to allow a certain local government 11 to assume the rights and obligations of an electric company under certain circumstances; prohibiting a local government from restricting or prohibiting 12 universal access for electricity or any other service under certain circumstances; 13 providing that certain provisions of law regarding high voltage lines do not 14

14 **(E)** (1) ANY PERSON WHO CONTROLS THE RIGHT TO USE SPACE ON ANY POLE, LAMPPOST, OR OTHER MOUNTING SURFACE PREVIOUSLY USED IN 15 THE LOCAL JURISDICTION BY THE ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR STREET LIGHTING 16 EQUIPMENT SHALL ALLOW A LOCAL GOVERNMENT THAT HAS PURCHASED THE 17 18 STREET LIGHTING EQUIPMENT TO ASSUME THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF 19 THE ELECTRIC COMPANY WITH RESPECT TO THE SPACE FOR THE UNEXPIRED 20 TERM OF ANY LEASE OR OTHER AGREEMENT UNDER WHICH THE ELECTRIC 21 COMPANY USED THE SPACE.

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY NOT RESTRICT OR PROHIBIT UNIVERSAL ACCESS
FOR ELECTRICITY OR ANY OTHER SERVICE BY ASSUMING THE RIGHTS AND
