- (e) (1) If a covered employee who is entitled to compensation under this Part V of this subtitle also receives federal Social Security disability insurance benefits, the adjusted annual compensation paid shall be reduced to the extent necessary to avoid a diminution of the federal Social Security disability insurance benefits.
- 10 (2) If federal Social Security law on disability insurance benefits no 11 longer imposes a diminution in the payment of the adjustment in compensation, 12 payments of compensation shall be made to the full extent allowed under this section.

- 14 **(A)** THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A NONGOVERNMENTAL UNIT THAT 15 EMPLOYS AT LEAST ONE COVERED EMPLOYEE.
- 16 **(B) A COVERED EMPLOYEE UNDER THIS SECTION MEANS AN** 17 **INDIVIDUAL WHO:**
- 18 (1) IS ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION FOR CLAIMS ARISING FROM
  19 EVENTS OCCURRING ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1988; AND
- 20 **(2)** FILED THE CLAIMS FOR COMPENSATION WITH A 21 NONGOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
- 22 (C) COMPENSATION PAID TO A COVERED EMPLOYEE UNDER THIS PART
  23 V OF THIS SUBTITLE IS SUBJECT TO AN ANNUAL COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT
  24 IF THE EMPLOYER CHOOSES TO PROVIDE AN ADJUSTMENT.
- 25 (D) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT OF
  26 BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SHALL DETERMINE AND REPORT TO
  27 THE COMMISSION THE RATE OF CHANGE IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX IN
  28 THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR, USING AS THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX THE
  29 LOWER OF:

- 1 (1) THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ALL URBAN CONSUMERS, ALL ITEM INDEX) PUBLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR THE WASHINGTON, D.C.-BALTIMORE CMSA; OR
- 4 (2) THE UNITED STATES CITY AVERAGE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX 5 (ALL URBAN CONSUMERS, ALL ITEM INDEX).
- 6 (E) ON OR BEFORE JULY 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE COMMISSION SHALL
  7 PUBLISH THE AMOUNT OF THE COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT THAT SHALL
  8 BECOME EFFECTIVE ON JANUARY 1 OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR.
- 9 **(F)** THE COMPENSATION PAYABLE TO A COVERED EMPLOYEE UNDER 10 THIS PART V OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE ADJUSTED BY:
- 11 (1) MULTIPLYING THE INITIAL RATE OF COMPENSATION BY THE 12 COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT; AND
- 13 **(2)** ADDING THE PRODUCT TO THE COMPENSATION, AS ADJUSTED, PAID DURING THE PRIOR YEAR.
- IF 15 (G) **(1)** Α COVERED **EMPLOYEE WHO** IS **ENTITLED** TO COMPENSATION UNDER THIS PART V OF THIS SUBTITLE ALSO RECEIVES 16 FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY INSURANCE BENEFITS, THE ADJUSTED 17 18 ANNUAL COMPENSATION PAID SHALL BE REDUCED TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY TO AVOID A DIMINUTION OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY 19 20 INSURANCE BENEFITS.
- 21 (2) IF FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY LAW ON DISABILITY
  22 INSURANCE BENEFITS NO LONGER IMPOSES A DIMINUTION IN THE PAYMENT OF
  23 THE ADJUSTMENT IN COMPENSATION, PAYMENTS OF COMPENSATION SHALL BE
  24 MADE TO THE FULL EXTENT ALLOWED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any compensation paid on or before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
