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Potomac River Fisheries Commission – Authority – Leasing Land Beneath
the Potomac River

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Potomac River Fisheries Commission to regulate leasing of certain lands under certain areas of the Potomac River for oyster and clam cultivation; authorizing the Commission to levy certain fees; making this Act subject to a certain contingency; and generally relating to the authority of the Potomac River Fisheries Commission.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (2) (I) LEASING OF THE RIVER BOTTOM AND THE WATER COLUMN FOR CULTIVATING OYSTERS OR CLAMS IN AREAS OF THE POTOMAC RIVER WITHIN ITS GEOGRAPHICAL JURISDICTION; AND
- (II) LEVYING OF LICENSE, LEASING, OR REPLETION FEES RELATED TO THE LEASING OF LAND BENEATH THE WATERS OF THE POTOMAC RIVER UNDER ITEM (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.
  - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not take effect until a similar Act is enacted by the Commonwealth of Virginia; that the Commonwealth of Virginia is requested to concur in this Act of the General Assembly of Maryland by the enactment of a similar Act; that the Department of Legislative Services shall notify the appropriate officials of the Commonwealth of Virginia of the enactment of this Act; and that upon the concurrence in this Act by the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Governor of the State of Maryland shall issue a proclamation declaring this Act valid and effective and shall forward a copy of the proclamation to the Executive Director of the Department of Legislative Services.
  - SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
