A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Aid for Police Protection – Supplemental Grants**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain supplemental grant for police protection to be
4 paid from the State to each municipality that contains a certain institution of
5 higher education with a certain undergraduate enrollment; requiring a certain
6 municipality to provide a certain matching fund for a supplemental grant
7 received under this Act; and generally relating to supplemental grants from the
8 State Aid for Police Protection Fund.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 41 – Governor – Executive and Administrative Departments**

17 4–403.

18 (b) Subject to subsection (d) of this section, for the fiscal year beginning July
19 1, 2004, and thereafter, the State shall pay to each subdivision, and to each qualifying
20 municipality, each year in the manner and subject to the limitations and requirements
21 hereinafter provided, an amount determined as follows:

1 (5) Supplemental Grant.

2 (i) In addition to the payments made under paragraphs (1), (2),
3 (3) and (4) of this subsection, the State shall pay:

4 1. To each subdivision, subject to subparagraph (ii) of
5 this paragraph, an amount the equivalent of \$2.50 per capita;

6 2. To Baltimore City, an amount the equivalent of fifty
7 cents per capita; [and]

8 3. To each subdivision that borders the District of
9 Columbia, in addition to the amount required under item 1 of this subparagraph, an
10 amount the equivalent of fifty cents per capita living in this State within 1 mile of the
11 border; **AND**

12 **4. SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS**
13 **PARAGRAPH, TO EACH QUALIFYING MUNICIPALITY THAT CONTAINS AN**
14 **INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, AS DEFINED IN § 10-101 OF THE**
15 **EDUCATION ARTICLE, WITH A FULL-TIME UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT OF**
16 **AT LEAST 24,000 ON ITS PRINCIPAL CAMPUS, IN ADDITION TO THE AMOUNT**
17 **REQUIRED UNDER ITEMS 1 AND 2 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, AN AMOUNT EQUAL**
18 **TO \$8 PER CAPITA.**

19 (ii) The State shall allocate and distribute the supplemental
20 grant to each subdivision among the subdivisions and the qualifying municipalities in
21 those subdivisions on a per capita basis.

22 **(III) A QUALIFYING MUNICIPALITY SHALL PROVIDE**
23 **MATCHING FUNDS FOR POLICE PROTECTION IN AN AMOUNT EQUIVALENT TO**
24 **THE SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT RECEIVED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I)4 OF THIS**
25 **PARAGRAPH.**

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 2007.
