2 **City of Annapolis – Housing Authority – Approval of Commissioners by City**
3 **Council**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that the Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the
5 City of Annapolis who are appointed by the Mayor of Annapolis be approved by
6 the Annapolis City Council; and generally relating to the Housing Authority of
7 the City of Annapolis.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Housing and Community Development**

16 13–104.

1 (a) (1) The Annapolis Authority consists of seven Commissioners
2 appointed by the Mayor of Annapolis **AND APPROVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY**
3 **COUNCIL.**

4 (2) Of the seven Commissioners:

5 (i) one shall be a tenant of an Annapolis Authority property
6 other than an Annapolis Authority property for seniors; and

7 (ii) one shall be a tenant of an Annapolis Authority property for
8 seniors.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2007.
