SENATE BILL 281

MARYLAND, That Section(s) 15–124.2 of Article – Health – General of the Annotated

Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 13–2501.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 5 read as follows: Article – Health – General 6 SUBTITLE 25. MARYLAND MEDBANK PROGRAM. 7 8 13 - 2501.9 In this section, "Program" means the Maryland Medbank Program (a)10 established under this section. 11 (b) There is a Maryland Medbank Program IN THE FAMILY HEALTH 12 ADMINISTRATION. 13 (c) The purpose of the Program is to improve the health status of individuals throughout the State who lack prescription drug coverage by providing access to 14 medically necessary prescription drugs through patient assistance programs 15 sponsored by pharmaceutical drug manufacturers. 16 Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Program shall be 17 (**d**) (1)administered by the Medbank of Maryland, Inc. 18 19 (2)The Medbank of Maryland, Inc. shall contract with one or more government or nonprofit entities to operate the Program. 20 21 (e) The Program shall be funded through a grant provided by the (1)22 Department. 23 (2)Program funds may be used in part to: 24 (i) Purchase interim supplies of prescription drugs for enrollees who have applied to participate in a manufacturer's patient assistance program but 25 have not yet received the approved prescription drug; and 26 Distribute medication to enrollees who have been approved 27 (ii) 28 to participate in a manufacturer's patient assistance program.

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1 (f) (1)The Medbank of Marvland, Inc. shall ensure that the Program is 2 available to residents in each of the following geographic regions of the State: 3 (i) Western Maryland; The Eastern Shore; 4 (ii) 5 (iii) The Baltimore metropolitan area; The 6 (iv)Maryland counties in the Washington, D.C. 7 metropolitan area; and 8 Southern Maryland, including Anne Arundel County. (**v**) 9 (2)Medbank of Maryland, Inc. shall be the central coordinating office for the State. 10 Eligibility for the Program shall be limited only by the criteria 11 (\mathbf{g}) established by pharmaceutical manufacturers for their patient assistance programs. 12 13 (h) (1)The Department shall require detailed financial reports at least quarterly from Medbank of Marvland, Inc. 14 The Medbank of Maryland, Inc. shall release funds to the entities 15 (2)that operate the Program as needed and justified by the guarterly reports filed in 16 accordance with paragraph (1) of this subsection. 17 18 On or before December 1, 2001, and annually thereafter, the Department (i) 19 and Medbank of Maryland, Inc. shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 20 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly, on the status of the 21 Maryland Medbank Program established under this section, including: 22 (1)The number and demographic characteristics of the State residents 23 served by the Program; The types and retail value of prescription drugs accessed through 24 (2)25 the Program; 26 (3)The nature and extent of outreach performed to inform State residents of the assistance available through the Program; and 27

1 (4) The total volume and retail value of each brand name drug, by 2 manufacturer, accessed through the Program.

3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 4 July 1, 2007.
