CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Local Law Enforcement Agencies - Disposal of Personal Property**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring local law enforcement agencies to hold certain personal
4 property that comes into their possession until certain determinations are made
5 subject to a certain exception; establishing a procedure for local law
6 enforcement agencies to notify the owner of the property and for the owner of
7 the property to secure the release of the property in a certain manner within a
8 certain period of time; authorizing a local law enforcement agency to sell certain
9 personal property in a certain manner after a certain period of time;
10 establishing that the amount received from the sale of personal property shall
11 be distributed in a certain order of priority to certain entities; requiring that a
12 certain remaining amount from the sale of personal property that was in the
13 possession of the Baltimore Police Department be divided equally among certain
14 entities; providing that a person who submits certain proof of the right to
15 possession of the property shall be paid a certain amount under certain
16 circumstances; providing that a certain claim is barred after a certain period of
17 time; providing for the interpretation of this Act; defining a certain term; and
18 generally relating to the disposal of personal property in the possession of local
19 law enforcement agencies.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article – Public Safety**

9 **3–505.**

10 (A) IN THIS SECTION, “LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY” MEANS THE
 11 POLICE DEPARTMENT OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THE
 12 STATE.

13 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO PERSONAL PROPERTY
 14 PURCHASED OR OTHERWISE ACQUIRED FOR USE BY A LOCAL LAW
 15 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR TO CONTRABAND.

16 (C) (1) ~~THE~~ EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
 17 SUBSECTION, THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL HOLD PERSONAL
 18 PROPERTY THAT COMES INTO THE POSSESSION OF THE LOCAL LAW
 19 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY UNTIL THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY
 20 DETERMINES THAT:

21 ~~(1)~~ (I) THE PROPERTY IS NO LONGER NEEDED IN CONNECTION
 22 WITH A PROSECUTION; OR

23 ~~(2)~~ (II) IF THE PROPERTY IS NOT CONNECTED TO A
 24 PROSECUTION, RETENTION OF THE PROPERTY IS NO LONGER RELEVANT TO THE
 25 LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

26 (2) PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS USED AS EVIDENCE IN A
 27 CRIMINAL PROSECUTION SHALL BE RETAINED BY A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
 28 AGENCY IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER EVIDENCE RETAINED BY THE AGENCY.

29 (D) (1) AFTER A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY DETERMINES
 30 THAT PERSONAL PROPERTY IS NO LONGER NEEDED IN CONNECTION WITH A
 31 PROSECUTION OR RETENTION OF THE PROPERTY IS NO LONGER RELEVANT TO

1 THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
2 AGENCY SHALL NOTIFY THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY THAT THE LOCAL LAW
3 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IS IN POSSESSION OF THE PROPERTY.

4 (2) AFTER NOTIFICATION, THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY HAS UP
5 TO 30 DAYS TO SECURE THE IMMEDIATE RELEASE OF THE PROPERTY TO THE
6 OWNER OR THE OWNER'S DESIGNEE WITH PROPER IDENTIFICATION.

7 (E) (1) AT ANY TIME AFTER PERSONAL PROPERTY HAS BEEN IN THE
8 POSSESSION OF A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR 3 MONTHS AND THE
9 LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY DETERMINES THAT THE PROPERTY IS NO
10 LONGER NEEDED IN CONNECTION WITH A PROSECUTION OR RETENTION OF THE
11 PROPERTY IS NO LONGER RELEVANT TO THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
12 AGENCY, THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL:

13 (I) GIVE NOTICE OF THE SALE OF THE PROPERTY BY
14 REGISTERED OR CERTIFIED MAIL TO THOSE PERSONS ENTITLED TO ITS
15 POSSESSION AND TO THOSE LIENHOLDERS WHOSE NAMES AND ADDRESSES CAN
16 BE ASCERTAINED BY THE EXERCISE OF REASONABLE DILIGENCE; AND

17 (II) PUBLISH A DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY AND THE
18 TIME, PLACE, AND TERMS OF THE SALE OF THE PROPERTY IN A NEWSPAPER OF
19 GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN EACH
20 OF TWO SUCCESSIVE WEEKS.

21 (2) AFTER COMPLYING WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF
22 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY
23 MAY SELL THE PROPERTY AT PUBLIC AUCTION.

24 (3) THE TERMS AND MANNER OF SALE MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY
25 RULE.

26 (F) THE CERTIFICATE OF THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY
27 THAT PERSONAL PROPERTY HAS BEEN SOLD UNDER THIS SECTION IS
28 SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE OF TITLE TO THE PROPERTY FOR ALL PURPOSES,
29 INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR REGISTRATION
30 FROM AN APPROPRIATE UNIT OF THE STATE.

1 **(G) (1) THE AMOUNT RECEIVED FROM THE SALE OF PERSONAL**
2 **PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED IN THE**
3 **FOLLOWING ORDER OF PRIORITY:**

4 **(I) FIRST, TO THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN**
5 **AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE EXPENSE OF SALE AND ALL EXPENSES INCURRED**
6 **WHILE THE PROPERTY WAS IN THE POSSESSION OF THE LOCAL LAW**
7 **ENFORCEMENT AGENCY;**

8 **(II) SECOND, TO LIENHOLDERS IN ORDER OF THEIR**
9 **PRIORITY; AND**

10 **(III) THIRD, TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE COUNTY OR**
11 **MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPHS (2), (3), AND (4) OF THIS**
12 **SUBSECTION.**

13 **(2) AFTER DISTRIBUTION OF THE AMOUNT RECEIVED FROM THE**
14 **SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT WAS IN THE POSSESSION OF THE**
15 **BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I) AND (II) OF THIS**
16 **SUBSECTION, ANY REMAINING AMOUNT SHALL BE DIVIDED EQUALLY AMONG:**

17 **(I) THE POLICE ATHLETIC LEAGUE OF BALTIMORE CITY;**

18 **(II) THE BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR**
19 **EQUIPMENT EXPENDITURES; AND**

20 **(III) THE BALTIMORE CITY GENERAL FUND.**

21 **(3) AT ANY TIME WITHIN 3 YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF A SALE**
22 **UNDER THIS SECTION, A PERSON WHO SUBMITS SATISFACTORY PROOF OF THE**
23 **RIGHT TO POSSESSION OF THE PROPERTY SHALL BE PAID, WITHOUT INTEREST,**
24 **THE AMOUNT DISTRIBUTED TO:**

25 **(I) THE GENERAL FUND OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL**
26 **CORPORATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION; OR**

27 **(II) THE BALTIMORE CITY GENERAL FUND UNDER**
28 **PARAGRAPH (2)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION.**

1 **(4) A CLAIM UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS**
2 **BARRED IF MORE THAN 3 YEARS HAS PASSED SINCE THE DATE OF A SALE UNDER**
3 **THIS SECTION.**

4 **(H) THIS SECTION DOES NOT CREATE OR RECOGNIZE ANY CAUSE,**
5 **ACTION, OR DEFENSE OR ABRIDGE ANY IMMUNITY NOW OR IN THE FUTURE**
6 **HELD BY A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR AN EMPLOYEE OF A LOCAL**
7 **LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2007.
