1 AN ACT concerning

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Education - Teachers - Merit-Based Pay

- FOR the purpose of requiring a county board of education to implement a system of merit-based pay if the majority of teachers, principals, and certain other personnel in a certain school are in favor of it, subject to certain conditions; subjecting the implementation of a system of merit-based pay to the availability of certain private funds donated for certain purposes; and generally relating to a system of merit-based pay for teachers, principals, and other certificated school-based personnel.

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1 TEACHERS IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL, IN RESTRUCTURING, INCLUDING PRINCIPALS 2 AND OTHER CERTIFICATED SCHOOL-BASED PERSONNEL, ARE IN FAVOR OF A 3 SYSTEM OF MERIT-BASED PAY, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL IMPLEMENT A 4 SYSTEM OF MERIT-BASED PAY FOR THE TEACHERS, PRINCIPALS, AND OTHER 5 CERTIFICATED SCHOOL-BASED PERSONNEL IN THAT PUBLIC SCHOOL.

6 (B) A SYSTEM OF MERIT-BASED PAY IMPLEMENTED UNDER THIS 7 SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF PRIVATE FUNDS 8 DONATED TO A PUBLIC SCHOOL OR PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE 9 OF IMPLEMENTING A SYSTEM OF MERIT-BASED PAY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
