4 FOR the purpose of ~~exempting from the State and local property tax~~ authorizing the
5 Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a county or
6 of a municipal corporation to grant, by law, a property tax credit for certain
7 property that is used as a business incubator; authorizing the county or
8 municipal corporation to provide, by law, for the amount and duration of the
9 credit and for certain provisions necessary to carry out this Act; defining a
10 certain term; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to
11 a State and local property tax exemption credit for certain property that is used
12 as a business incubator.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BUSINESS INCUBATOR" MEANS A PROGRAM IN
4 WHICH UNITS OF SPACE ARE LEASED BY MULTIPLE EARLY-STAGE BUSINESSES
5 THAT SHARE PHYSICAL COMMON SPACE, ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND
6 EQUIPMENT, BUSINESS MANAGEMENT TRAINING, MENTORING, AND TECHNICAL
7 SUPPORT.

8 (B) ~~PROPERTY THAT IS USED AS A BUSINESS INCUBATOR IS NOT~~
9 ~~SUBJECT TO PROPERTY TAX~~ THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
10 CITY OR THE GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR OF A MUNICIPAL
11 CORPORATION MAY GRANT, BY LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT AGAINST THE
12 COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON PROPERTY THAT IS USED
13 AS A BUSINESS INCUBATOR IF THE STATE, A COUNTY, A MUNICIPAL

18 (1) OWNS, CONTROLS, OR LEASES THE SPACE THAT IS USED AS A
19 BUSINESS INCUBATOR;

20 (2) PROVIDES AT LEAST 50% OF THE TOTAL FUNDING RECEIVED
21 BY THE BUSINESS INCUBATOR FROM ALL SOURCES, NOT INCLUDING RENTS
22 RECEIVED FROM INCUBATOR TENANT FIRMS; OR

23 (3) IS REPRESENTED ON THE GOVERNANCE BOARD THAT
24 AUTHORIZES THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE BUSINESS INCUBATOR.

25 (C) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE
26 GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY PROVIDE,
27 BY LAW, FOR:

28 (1) THE AMOUNT AND DURATION OF THE PROPERTY TAX CREDIT
29 UNDER THIS SECTION;

1 **(2) ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE TAX CREDIT**
2 **UNDER THIS SECTION;**

3 **(3) REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE APPLICATION AND**
4 **UNIFORM PROCESSING OF REQUESTS FOR THE TAX CREDIT; AND**

5 **(4) ANY OTHER PROVISION NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS**
6 **SECTION.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 June 1, 2007, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30,
9 2007.
