2 Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners - Partially Elected Board - Straw Ballot

FOR the purpose of requiring that a question be placed on the ballot in Baltimore City at the November general election of 2007 to determine the sense of the voters of Baltimore City on the issue of whether the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners should be changed from a system of members appointed jointly by the Mayor of Baltimore City and the Governor to a mixed system composed of some members who are appointed by the Mayor of Baltimore City and the Governor and some members who are elected by the voters of Baltimore City; providing for the carrying out of the straw ballot; and generally relating to the holding of a straw ballot in Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That under the provisions of the Election Law Article, the Baltimore City Board of Elections, in consultation with the State Board of Elections, shall prepare and include on the ballot for the November general election of 2007 the following question:

Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from the law by amendment.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take eff. June 1, 2007.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Baltimore City Bo of Elections and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City shall do those this necessary and proper to place this question on the ballot prepared for the Novem general election of 2007, so that each participating voter in Baltimore City may he the opportunity to cast a vote on the question. The question shall be proposed presented, tallied, and reported in general accordance with the provisions of Election Law Article. The vote on this question is advisory only.
"Do you favor changing the method of selection of the members of the Baltim City Board of School Commissioners from the current method of having all of members (except for the student member) appointed jointly by the Mayor of Baltim City and the Governor to a mixed method of having some of the members join appointed by the Mayor of Baltimore City and the Governor and some of the member elected by the voters of Baltimore City?"
