2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005 – Prince George’s County**
3 **– Langley Park Multi-Service Center**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005
5 to change the name of the Victory Youth Center to the Langley Park
6 Multi-Service Center and change the name of a certain grantee from the Board
7 of Directors of the Victory Youth Centers, Inc. to the Catholic Archdiocese of
8 Washington; expanding the authorized uses of the loan proceeds and matching
9 fund; and generally relating to the Langley Park Multi-Service Center.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
11 Chapter 445 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2005
12 Section 1(3) Item ZA00 (AH)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 445 of the Acts of 2005

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(3) ZA00 MISCELLANEOUS GRANT PROGRAMS

(AH) [Victory Youth Center.] **LANGLEY PARK MULTI-SERVICE CENTER.** Provide a grant to the [Board of Directors of the Victory Youth Centers, Inc.] **CATHOLIC ARCHDIOCESE OF WASHINGTON** to assist in the design, construction, and capital equipping of a **CLINIC, SOCIAL SERVICE CENTER, AND** gymnasium to serve the youth of the community of Langley Park in Prince George’s County (Prince George’s County)..... 550,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2007.
