Major athletic field lighting system replacement and upgrade at three Baltimore County recreation sites: County Home Park, General John Stricker Middle School Recreation Center, and Shelbourne Park. Aged lighting systems will be replaced with new lighting that meets modern safety standards, with area of illumination expanded where possible to allow for practice and warm-up in areas adjacent to the field of play. All County lighting systems are designed and constructed to be energy efficient and are equipped with glare-control devices to effectively reduce light spillover.
