Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 552 - *Education - Relocatable Classrooms - Indoor Air Quality Standards*.

This bill requires the Board of Public Works, in consultation with the Department of General Services and the Department of Housing and Community Development, to adopt regulations establishing criteria designed to enhance indoor air quality in relocatable classrooms that may be purchased or leased with State or local funds. The bill applies only prospectively to relocatable classrooms purchased after the bill's effective date.

House Bill 164, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 552.
