A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Maryland Education Fund – Establishment and Funding**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Education Fund as a special,
4 nonlapsing fund; establishing the purpose and contents of the Fund; requiring
5 the State Superintendent of Schools to administer the Fund and to adopt
6 certain regulations; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund separately
7 and to invest the money of the Fund in a certain manner; requiring the
8 Comptroller to account for the Fund; providing that expenditures from the Fund
9 may be made only in a certain manner; providing that on a certain date the
10 balance remaining on a gift certificate shall be presumed to be abandoned;
11 requiring a person that sells or issues gift certificates in the State to remit to
12 the Comptroller the remaining balances on certain gift certificates on or before a
13 certain date each year; requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain revenues
14 to the Maryland Education Fund on or before a certain date each year; altering
15 the information that must be printed on a gift certificate, a sticker permanently
16 affixed to a gift certificate, or an envelope containing a gift certificate; requiring
17 a person that sells or issues a gift certificate in the State to maintain accounts,
18 books, and records relating to the sale and issuance of the gift certificate for a
19 certain period of time; requiring the person to make the accounts, books, and
20 records available for inspection by the Comptroller on request; defining a
21 certain term; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to the
22 Maryland Education Fund and abandoned gift certificates.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article – Commercial Law**

9 14–1319.

10 (a) (1) In this section, “gift certificate” means a device constructed of
11 paper, plastic, or any other material that is:

12 (i) Sold or issued by a person for a cash value that can be used
13 to purchase goods or services; or

14 (ii) Issued as a store credit for returned goods.

15 (2) “Gift certificate” does not include:

16 (i) A prepaid telephone calling card;

17 (ii) A prepaid technical support card;

18 (iii) A prepaid card for Internet services;

19 (iv) A coupon for discounted goods or services;

20 (v) A gift certificate that is distributed to an individual under
21 an awards, loyalty, or promotional program in which the recipient does not give money
22 or value for the gift certificate; [or]

23 (vi) A gift card that:

24 1. Is processed through a national credit or debit card
25 service; and

26 2. May be used to purchase goods or services from
27 multiple unaffiliated sellers of goods or services;

28 **(VII) A GIFT CERTIFICATE THAT IS SOLD BY A CHARITABLE**
29 **OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION;**

1 **(VIII) A CARD ISSUED BY AN EMPLOYER TO AN EMPLOYEE AS**
2 **PROOF OF WAGES PAID TO THE EMPLOYEE; OR**

3 **(IX) A CARD ISSUED BY A PUBLIC TRANSIT FACILITY FOR**
4 **THE PAYMENT OF ANY TRANSIT FARES, PARKING FEES, OR TRANSIT-RELATED**
5 **EXPENSES.**

6 (b) A person may not sell or issue a gift certificate that, within 4 years after
7 the date of purchase, is subject to expiration or a fee or charge of any kind.

8 **(C) (1) THE BALANCE REMAINING ON A GIFT CERTIFICATE SHALL BE**
9 **PRESUMED TO BE ABANDONED ON THE LATER OF:**

10 **(I) THE DATE THAT IS 4 YEARS AFTER THE DATE THE GIFT**
11 **CERTIFICATE IS PURCHASED; OR**

12 **(II) THE DATE THAT IS 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF THE**
13 **LAST PURCHASE MADE USING THE GIFT CERTIFICATE.**

14 **(2) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1 OF EACH YEAR, A PERSON THAT**
15 **SELLS OR ISSUES GIFT CERTIFICATES IN THE STATE SHALL REMIT TO THE**
16 **COMPTROLLER THE BALANCE REMAINING ON EACH GIFT CERTIFICATE THAT**
17 **WAS PRESUMED ABANDONED DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR.**

18 **(3) ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE COMPTROLLER**
19 **SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE REVENUES RECEIVED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS**
20 **SUBSECTION TO THE MARYLAND EDUCATION FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER §**
21 **5-201.1 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.**

22 [(c)] **(D)** Any term or condition concerning expiration or a fee or charge that
23 takes effect more than 4 years after the date of purchase, **AND NOTICE OF THE**
24 **PRESUMPTION OF ABANDONMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION,**
25 must be printed clearly in at least 10 point type in a visible place on:

26 (1) The front or back of the gift certificate;

27 (2) A sticker permanently affixed to the gift certificate; or

28 (3) An envelope containing the gift certificate.

29 [(d)] **(E)** Unless the change benefits the consumer, a term or condition
30 disclosed under subsection [(c)] **(D)** of this section may not be changed after the date of
31 purchase or issuance.

1 **(F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:**

2 **(1) REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FUND FROM ABANDONED**
3 **GIFT CERTIFICATES UNDER § 14-1319 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE;**

4 **(2) INVESTMENT EARNINGS; AND**

5 **(3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED**
6 **FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.**

7 **(G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO SUPPORT PUBLIC SCHOOL**
8 **EDUCATION.**

9 **(H) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO**
10 **CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND.**

11 **(I) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE**
12 **FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.**

13 **(2) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE**
14 **CREDITED TO THE FUND.**

15 **(J) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN**
16 **ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.**

17 **(K) MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE FUND FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL**
18 **EDUCATION IS SUPPLEMENTAL TO AND IS NOT INTENDED TO TAKE THE PLACE**
19 **OF FUNDING THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE APPROPRIATED FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL**
20 **EDUCATION.**

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2008.
