AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 450

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Hammen and Nathan-Pulliam" and substitute "Hammen, Nathan-Pulliam, Pendergrass, Beitzel, Benson, Bromwell, Costa, Donoghue, Elliott, Hubbard, Kach, Kipke, McDonough, Mizeur, Montgomery, Morhaim, Oaks, Pena-Melnyk, Reznik, Riley, Tarrant, V. Turner, and Weldon"; in line 2, after the second "Health" insert "and Disabilities"; and strike beginning with "requiring" in line 7 down through "State" in line 10 and substitute "requiring the Secretary to develop a certain system of services for certain individuals, to address systems change in a certain manner, and to identify and implement certain individualized treatment and supports".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 24, after "HEALTH" insert "AND DISABILITIES".

On page 2, in line 13, strike "Health" and substitute "<u>Hygiene</u>"; in line 15, strike "Services" and substitute "<u>and Disabilities</u>".

On pages 2 and 3, strike beginning with "develop" in line 16 on page 2 down through "and" in line 5 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute "<u>for individuals with cooccurring disorders</u>, develop a coordinated system of individualized services, in the <u>most integrated setting</u>;

- (3) address systems change to best serve individuals with co-occurring disorders, that includes:
 - (i) best practices, program standards, and design;

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(ii) identification and utilization of screening and assessment tools;

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- (iii) integration of treatment plans and supports;
- (iv) staff competencies and cross-disciplinary training; and
- (v) measurable outcomes;
- (4) identify and implement individualized treatment and supports, consistent with standards and best practices from each discipline; and".

On page 3, in line 6, strike "(4)" and substitute "(5)".
