AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Vaughn" and substitute "<u>Vaughn</u>, <u>Benson, Montgomery, Morhaim, Oaks, and Pena–Melnyk</u>"; in line 3, strike "Reports" and substitute "<u>Report</u>"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 8 down through "manner;" in line 13 and substitute "<u>requiring the Commissioner or a designee of the Commissioner to submit the report to certain legislative committees; providing for the termination of this Act;"; and in line 14, after "to" insert "<u>reports on</u>".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 3, strike "AND"; in line 5, after "EXAMINATION" insert ": AND

(V) THE CORRECT ANSWER RATE AND CORRELATION FOR EACH TEST QUESTION AND EACH TEST FORM";

and strike beginning with "(F)" in line 6 down through "CORRELATIONS" in line 15 and substitute:

"(3) As soon as practicable after its publication, the Commissioner or a designee of the Commissioner shall submit the Report, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 17, after "2008." insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of September 30, 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
