AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 586

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute "Statewide Advisory Commission on Immunizations – Influenza Vaccines – Study"; in line 3, strike beginning with "prohibiting" in line 3 down through "mercury" in line 10 and substitute "requiring the Statewide Advisory Commission on Immunizations to conduct a certain study; requiring the Commission to make a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the Statewide Advisory Commission on Immunizations and a study on the influenza vaccine"; and strike in their entirety lines 11 through 15, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 17, after "That" insert a colon.

On pages 1 and 2, strike beginning with "the" in line 17 on page 1 through "**MERCURY.**" in line 7 on page 2 and substitute:

"(a) The Statewide Advisory Commission on Immunizations shall:

(1) Study the current availability and anticipated future availability of single-dose influenza vaccines for use in the State; and

(2) Identify the current and anticipated future cost differential between single-dose and multi-dose influenza vaccines; and

(b) On or before December 1, 2008, the Commission shall report its findings, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Education,
