## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Oversight Committee on Quality of Care in Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities - Duties

FOR the purpose of requiring the Oversight Committee on Quality of Care in Nursing
Homes and Assisted Living Facilities to consider the quality of life in nursing
homes, assisted living facilities, and senior independent living facilities; and
generally relating to the duties of the Oversight Committee on Quality of Care
in Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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### Article – Health – General
