Agriculture - Maryland Dairy Farmer Emergency Trust Fund

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Dairy Farmer Emergency Trust Fund; 4 establishing the purpose and uses of the Fund; requiring the Secretary of Agriculture to administer the Fund and establish certain procedures; requiring 5 6 that certain unspent or unencumbered funds, in excess of a certain amount, 7 revert to the General Fund of the State; specifying that the State Treasurer shall hold the Fund separately and that the Comptroller shall account for the 8 9 Fund; designating the moneys to be deposited into the Fund; requiring authorizing the Governor to appropriate to the Fund a certain amount to make 10 an appropriation to the Fund each fiscal year; and generally relating to the 11 Maryland Dairy Farmer Emergency Trust Fund. 12
