- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Gasoline Zone-Pricing in Maryland; specifying the membership and duties of the Task Force; providing 4 5 for the appointment of a Senate co-chair and House co-chair of the Task Force; providing for the staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task 6 7 Force from receiving compensation for serving on the Task Force; authorizing a member of the Task Force to receive reimbursement for certain expenses; 8 9 requiring a certain report on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of the Task Force; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study 10 Gasoline Zone-Pricing in Maryland. 11
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 - (a) There is a Task Force to Study Gasoline Zone–Pricing in Maryland.

- (g) The Task Force shall submit an interim report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, subject to § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly on or before December 1, 2008, and submit a final report to the Governor and, subject to § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly on or before December 1, 2009.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2010, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
