17 18	WHEREAS, Health care disparities exist in access to hospital and specialty care for minority populations; and
19 20	WHEREAS, Managed care organizations serve minority populations under the Maryland Medical Assistance Program; and
21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, In an effort to reduce health care disparities, academic hospitals and their affiliated specialty care networks have a responsibility to contract with managed care organizations that serve minority populations under the Maryland Medical Assistance Program; now, therefore,



- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 5 (A) IF AN ACADEMIC HOSPITAL IS RECEIVING STATE FUNDS IN ANY
- 6 FORM, INCLUDING BUILDING GRANTS OR TAX INCENTIVES, THE DEPARTMENT
- 7 SHALL REQUIRE THE ACADEMIC HOSPITAL AND ITS AFFILIATED SPECIALTY
- 8 CARE NETWORKS, ON REQUEST OF A MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION, TO
- 9 CONTRACT WITH THE MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION TO PROVIDE HOSPITAL
- 10 AND SPECIALTY CARE TO MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM RECIPIENTS IF THE
