- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17(A) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO INVALIDATE ANY OTHER18PROVISION OF THIS TITLE.

- 19(B) Only a marriage between [a man and a woman] TWO INDIVIDUALS WHO20ARE NOT OTHERWISE PROHIBITED FROM MARRYING is valid in this State.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an official of a religious 22 institution or body authorized to solemnize marriages may not be required to 23 solemnize any marriage in violation of the right to free exercise of religion guaranteed
