A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City Public Schools - High School Students - Voter Education**

3 FOR the purpose of declaring the intent of the General Assembly that, at a certain
4 time, teachers of high school students enrolled in Baltimore City public schools
5 inform students about certain election processes, including certain information;
6 and generally relating to voter education of high school students enrolled in
7 Baltimore City public schools.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 4-309.

17 (D) **IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT TEACHERS OF**
18 **BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS, DURING AN ELECTION**
19 **YEAR, INFORM STUDENTS OF THE ELECTION PROCESS IN THE UNITED STATES**
20 **AND THE STATE, INCLUDING THE IMPORTANCE OF EXERCISING THE RIGHT TO**
21 **VOTE AND REGISTERING TO VOTE.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2008.
