AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 302

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 9, after “circumstances” insert “; providing that at the expiration of the temporary or final protective order, the respondent or a certain individual designated by the respondent at the time of the surrender of the firearm may retake possession of the firearm; requiring the Department of State Police to adopt certain regulations”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, after line 22, insert:

“(C) (1) AT THE EXPIRATION OF A TEMPORARY OR FINAL PROTECTIVE ORDER, THE RESPONDENT OR AN INDIVIDUAL DESIGNATED BY THE RESPONDENT AT THE TIME OF THE SURRENDER OF THE FIREARM WHO IS LEGALLY QUALIFIED TO POSSESS THE FIREARM MAY RETAKE POSSESSION OF THE FIREARM.

(2) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO ENSURE THAT A FIREARM IS PROMPTLY RETURNED TO THE RESPONDENT OR THE INDIVIDUAL DESIGNATED BY THE RESPONDENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.”
