AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 533

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after “other” insert “State, local, and not-for-profit”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 7 down through “procurement;” in line 9; in line 9, strike “State and”; strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 11 down through “circumstances;” in line 15; and in line 15, after “intent;” insert “requiring certain units of State government to publish on a website a list of certain procurement solicitations;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in lines 11 and 12, strike “: (I)”; strike beginning with “; AND” in line 14 down through “\$750,000” in line 16; and in lines 18 and 19, strike “, LEGISLATIVE, OR JUDICIAL”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in lines 21 and 22, strike “SMALL PROCUREMENT AS DEFINED BY § 13-109 OF THIS SUBTITLE” and substitute “A PROCUREMENT WITH A PROJECTED VALUE OF LESS THAN \$100,000”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5, strike in their entirety lines 12 through 15, inclusive; in line 16, strike “(F)” and substitute “(E)”; and in the same line, strike “STATE OR”.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On pages 5 through 7, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 25 on page 5 through line 13 on page 7, inclusive.

(Over)

On page 7, in line 18, after “Services” insert “, the Department of Transportation, the Department of Information Technology,”; strike beginning with “work” in line 18 down through “newsletters” in line 21 and substitute “publish on a website a list of all procurement solicitations reasonably expected to have a projected value of \$100,000 or more that are submitted by a procurement agency in accordance with COMAR 21.11.03.08”; in line 30, strike the second “and”; and in line 32, after “procurement” insert “; and

(4) methods for maximizing the opportunity for small businesses to compete for intergovernmental cooperative purchasing contracts that are not solicited through eMaryland Marketplace”.
