AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 409
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, before “Public” insert “Anne Arundel County”; in line 3, strike “State” and substitute “Anne Arundel County”; in lines 3 and 5, in each instance, strike “model”; in line 5, strike “by” and substitute “on or before”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 6 down through “date;” in line 13 and substitute “requiring the county board to implement a certain policy in certain public schools in a certain school year; requiring the county board to submit a certain report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date;”; in line 13, after “term;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act;”; and in line 14, strike “public schools” and substitute “the Anne Arundel County Board of Education”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “STATE” in line 1 down through “SYSTEMS,” in line 2 and substitute “ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION”; in line 3, strike “MODEL”; in line 4, after “SCHOOLS” insert “WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD.”

(2) THE ACCOUNTABILITY POLICY DEVELOPED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:

(I) A SYSTEM FOR ASSIGNING EACH OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL A UNIQUE NUMBER; AND

(II) A METHOD FOR PROVIDING A COPY OF THE NUMBERED OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL TO THE INDIVIDUAL SUBMITTING THE OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL AT THE TIME IT IS SUBMITTED;

and strike in their entirety lines 5 through 30, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 and 2 and substitute:

“(C) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL IMPLEMENT THE POLICY DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IN ALL SCHOOLS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD IN THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR.

(D) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2012, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE IMPLEMENTATION AND STATUS OF THE OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL ACCOUNTABILITY POLICY IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.”;

and in line 4, after “2009.” insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of June 30, 2013, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
