A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – School Administrators – Reports of Violence to Local Law**
3 **Enforcement Unit**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a school administrator to report to a local law
5 enforcement unit certain acts of violence on school property resulting in injuries
6 requiring certain medical attention; requiring certain school administrators to
7 provide a certain notice to a certain county board of education; and generally
8 relating to reporting acts of violence on school property to local law enforcement
9 units.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 **7–430.**

19 (A) **A SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR SHALL REPORT TO THE LOCAL LAW**
20 **ENFORCEMENT UNIT ANY ACT OF VIOLENCE COMMITTED BY A STUDENT OR**
21 **ADULT ON SCHOOL PROPERTY THAT RESULTS IN AN INJURY REQUIRING A CALL**
22 **TO EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR MEDICAL ATTENTION.**

23 (B) **A SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR THAT MAKES A REPORT TO A LOCAL**
24 **LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL**

1 **PROVIDE NOTICE OF THE REPORT TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION WITH**
2 **JURISDICTION OVER THE SCHOOL AT WHICH THE INCIDENT TOOK PLACE.**

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 July 1, 2009.
