5	(ii) Subject to subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, a member of the Maryland National Guard who has not been activated under Title 10 of the United States Code, shall receive service credit at the rate of 4 months for each full year of service with the Maryland National Guard, not to exceed a total of 36 months.

- (d) The service credit for military service that an individual receives under this section shall be applied to the individual's retirement allowance using the accrual rate in effect at the time the individual retires from a State system.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 July 1, 2009.
