## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 **Washington County – Board of Education – President and Members Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the president and members of the  
4 Washington County Board of Education; providing that this Act does not apply  
5 to the salary or compensation of an incumbent president or member of the  
6 county board; repealing a provision that requires the members of the  
7 Washington County Board of Education to have their compensation paid in a  
8 certain number of installments; and generally relating to the salary of the  
9 president and members of the Washington County Board of Education.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Article – Education  
12 Section 3–1302(a)(1)  
13 Annotated Code of Maryland  
14 (2008 Replacement Volume)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 17 **Article – Education**

18 3–1302.

19 (a) (1) The president of the county board is entitled to receive [\$5,600]  
20 **\$6,200** annually as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §  
4 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to  
5 the salary or compensation of the president and members in office on the effective date  
6 of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the  
7 president and members shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of  
8 office.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
10 October 1, 2009.
