## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Radiation Therapists, Radiographers, Nuclear Medicine Technologists, and**  
3 **Radiologist Assistants – Renewal Requirements for Licenses**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain renewal requirement for certain licensed  
5 radiation therapists, radiographers, nuclear medicine technologists, and  
6 radiologist assistants; requiring certain licensees to meet any additional license  
7 renewal requirements established by the State Board of Physicians; and  
8 generally relating to radiation therapists, radiographers, nuclear medicine  
9 technologists, and radiologist assistants.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Article – Health Occupations  
12 Section 14–5B–12(c)  
13 Annotated Code of Maryland  
14 (2005 Replacement Volume and 2008 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Health Occupations**

18 14–5B–12.

19 (c) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, before a license expires, the  
20 licensed individual may periodically renew it for an additional term, if the individual:

21 [(1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

22 (2)] (1) Pays to the Board a renewal fee set by the Board; [and

23 (3)] (2) Submits to the Board:

1 (i) A renewal application on the form that the Board requires;  
2 and

3 (ii) Satisfactory evidence of compliance with any continuing  
4 education or competency requirements and other requirements required by the Board  
5 for license renewal; **AND**

6 **(3) MEETS ANY ADDITIONAL RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS**  
7 **ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 2009.
