1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Homeowners Association Act – Closed Meetings of Homeowners**
3 **Association**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain condition on which a meeting of the board of
5 directors or other governing body of a homeowners association or a committee of
6 a homeowners association may be held in closed session; altering certain
7 conditions on which a meeting of a governing body or committee of a
8 homeowners association may be held in closed session; authorizing a governing
9 body or committee of a homeowners association to hold a meeting in closed
10 session in order to discuss an individual owner assessment account; and
11 generally relating to closed meetings of a homeowners association.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article – Real Property**

2 11B–111.

3 Except as provided in this title, and notwithstanding anything contained in any
4 of the documents of the homeowners association:

5 (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (4) of this section, all
6 meetings of the homeowners association, including meetings of the board of directors
7 or other governing body of the homeowners association or a committee of the
8 homeowners association, shall be open to all members of the homeowners association
9 or their agents;

10 (4) A meeting of the board of directors or other governing body of the
11 homeowners association or a committee of the homeowners association may be held in
12 closed session only for the following purposes:

13 (i) Discussion of matters pertaining to employees and
14 personnel;

15 (ii) Protection of the privacy or reputation of individuals in
16 matters not related to the homeowners association's business;

17 (iii) Consultation with legal counsel ON LEGAL MATTERS;

18 (iv) Consultation with staff personnel, consultants, attorneys,
19 BOARD MEMBERS, or other persons in connection with pending or potential litigation
20 OR OTHER LEGAL MATTERS;

21 (v) Investigative proceedings concerning possible or actual
22 criminal misconduct;

23 (vi) Consideration of the terms or conditions of a business
24 transaction in the negotiation stage if the disclosure could adversely affect the
25 economic interests of the homeowners association; ~~OR~~

26 (vii) Compliance with a specific constitutional, statutory, or
27 judicially imposed requirement protecting particular proceedings or matters from
28 public disclosure; [or

29 (viii) On an individually recorded affirmative vote of two-thirds of
30 the board or committee members present, some other exceptional reason so compelling
31 as to override the general public policy in favor of open meetings;] ~~and~~ OR

32 (VIII) DISCUSSION OF INDIVIDUAL OWNER ASSESSMENT
33 ACCOUNTS; AND

1 (5) If a meeting is held in closed session under paragraph (4) of this
2 section:

3 (i) An action may not be taken and a matter may not be
4 discussed if it is not permitted by paragraph (4) of this section; and

5 (ii) A statement of the time, place, and purpose of a closed
6 meeting, the record of the vote of each board or committee member by which the
7 meeting was closed, and the authority under this section for closing a meeting shall be
8 included in the minutes of the next meeting of the board of directors or the committee
9 of the homeowners association.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2009.
