- 3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 5 Article Education
- 6 **7-112.1.**
- 7 (A) SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE 8 DEPARTMENT MAY DEVELOP A STANDARDIZED COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM TO 9 FACILITATE THE COLLECTION OF DATA ON STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN 10 COURSES OFFERED BY THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
- 11 (B) THE COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR ADOPTION BY EACH COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS.
- 13 (C) If the Department requires a data collection involving 14 course numbers, a county school system that has not adopted the 15 State standardized course numbering system shall be responsible 16 for providing a translation between the county school system's 17 course numbers and those in the State standardized course 18 numbering system.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the
 General Assembly that a county school system that has not adopted the State
 standardized course numbering system and is responsible for providing a translation
 between the county school system's course numbers and those in the State standardized
 course numbering system, as required under Section 1 of this Act, may be able to access
 and use any federal or State funds otherwise available in order to mitigate the fiscal
 impact of this Act to the county school system.
- SECTION $\frac{2}{2}$ AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
